All NWIBRT members are invited to participate by submitting their monthly safety statistics, including total hours worked, OSHA recordables, DART rates, and other key safety metrics.

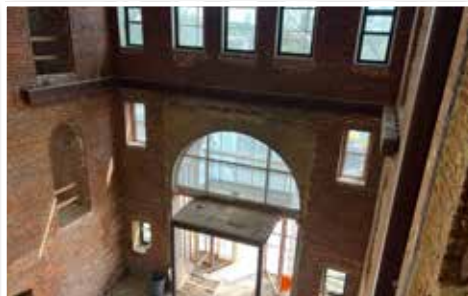
All submissions are utilized for cumulative data only. The monthly cumulative reports are shared with participating companies to encourage collaboration and continuous improvement.

DRIVE CLINE & SAVE!

HOW IT WORKS

This program lets non-commercial Cline Avenue Bridge users take the bridge for more of their daily travels by saving 50% on each trip across the bridge.

TO GET STARTED

- 1: Enroll your 2-axle vehicle and transponder by scanning the QR code. (Only 2-axle vehicles are eligible.)
- 2: Once your registration is confirmed, the discount starts with your third trip across the bridge.
- 3: Cross Cline Avenue Bridge paying directly from your fully funded I-PASS or EZPass at time of travel. Every 90 days you are required to make two crossings at regular price to maintain program eligibility.

- **I-PASS:** getipass.com or in-store at Jewel-Osco.
- **E-ZPass:** indianatollroad.com or in-store at CVS.
